

YOU ARE INVITED – HEADINGLEY HOUSING STUDY FINDINGS WORKSHOP

Dear Resident of Headingley,

Landmark Planning & Design has been retained by the RM of Headingley to develop a Housing Vision and Study for the Municipality. The Housing Vision and Study will provide the RM with direction to help guide residential development and growth into the future. The Study will include an analysis of:

- Lot sizes
- Housing density
- Housing types
- Built form and design criteria, and
- Housing locations

Stakeholder engagement and public consultation are key components of this planning process. On April 30th, the project team hosted an initial Community Workshop. The goals of that workshop were to introduce the project, present background study findings, discuss housing details, understand residents' thoughts on a wide range of housing issues, and begin to establish a vision for housing in Headingley.

- Present the findings of the study to date
- Review a summary of the online survey results
- Offer an additional opportunity for resident input, and
